<b>In attendance</b>	Present were Cllrs Stan Davies (Chairman), Clare Davies, Latham, Bourne, Goodwin, Mills, Benson and Proctor.
<b>Minutes of the last meeting</b>	Minutes of the last meeting held on 20th October were approved and signed by the Chairman
<b>Matters arising</b>	<p>Cllr Latham to contact Mrs Libby Latham to ask if she would like to stand as a Parish Councillor.</p> <p>Flagpole sign – Clerk to pursue and purchase prior to the next meeting.</p> <p>Footpath between Coppermine Lane and Bickerton Poacher – this needs to be reinstated without delay – it was proposed to use some of the Parish Council funds to assist with this.</p> <p>The posts outside Bickerton House and Goldford Stud have still not been removed, despite the Council saying they were going to write to the householders asking for this to happen – Clerk to chase up progress.</p>
<b>Accounts</b>	Bank balance £4,208.68. Payments to be made £15 for room hire and £25 for the poppy wreath that was purchased by the Chairman. The annual precept was discussed, It was proposed by Cllr Goodwin and seconded by Cllr Latham to precept for £2500.00.
<b>Highways</b>	Harthill Lane – the overgrowing hedge and verge are making this stretch of road very dangerous when cars meet there.
<b>Correspondence</b>	<p>The Clerk showed the meeting leaflets which have been asked to be displayed regarding everyone who wants to vote at a polling station must now show photo ID.</p> <p>A planning application has been received from Cllr Proctor for alterations to his property – the Chairman asked the meeting if they were happy for Cllr Proctor to remain in the room whilst it was discussed and they were all in agreement. It was decided that no representations were to be made.</p>
