<b>Apologies</b>	Apologies were received from Cllrs Benson, Proctor and Mills
<b>In attendance</b>	Present were Cllrs Stan Davies (Chairman), Clare Davies, Latham, Bourne, Goodwin, and Burrows
<b>Minutes of the last meeting</b>	Minutes of the last meeting held on 21 <sup>st</sup> July were approved and signed by the Chairman
<b>Matters arising</b>	Quarry Lane – in urgent need of resurfacing.
<b>Accounts</b>	Bank balance £3,457.94. Payments to be made £15 room hire agreed.
<b>Highways</b>	Footpath on A534, Chairman to find out if this can be reinstated. Church junction patching required on the Brunty Bank side at the bottom of the bank at the junction with Long Lane. Fingerposts – Clerk reported that one had been put back in place on the A534 junction – Cllr Burrows and Goodwin to put the other two back. Consideration was given to where the fingerpost by the School should be sited as there is now very little verge left where it was originally. A534 – Clerk to ask highways if the double white lines could be extended passed the junction by the Village Hall as exiting from Long Lane heading towards Wrexham there is a blind spot and cars have been known to overtake here. Large pot hole opposite Goldford Farm Double yellow lines to be put in place outside the church to stop people walking the hill Pot holes in the area to be reported to Highways Department.
